Neither the BSPS or any of its officers, assistants or stewards shall in any way be responsible for any loss, injury or damages that may happen to exhibitors or their assistants or other members of the public, or to any animal or property or to any vehicle brought into the Showground or on any premises used in conjunction with the Show, or while entering or leaving the same. It is necessary all exhibitors carry Public Liability Insurance for an adequate Indemnity to protect against their negligence including any injury caused by their animals or property. You accept being around horses and riding at any standard has inherent risk and that all horses may react unpredictably on occasions. You may fall off and could be injured or be injured by another horse. By entering you accept these risks. It is advisable you take out your own Personal Accident Insurance to cover you against the risks of injury

2. The organizers reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any classes if there are insufficient entries or to amend the conditions of any class at their discretion.

3. Entries will not be acknowledged unless a stamped addressed envelope is submitted with the entry.

4. No numbers will be sent to exhibitors before the show date. Competitors' numbers to be collected from the secretary's office on showground.

5. <u>Membership and Registration will be suspended immediately, if cheques payable to the BSPS., the BSPS Championships Show or a BSPS Area are not honoured by the bank or if there is any money owing to the BSPS, the Championships Show or a BSPS Area or a BSPS Affiliated show or if ANY TROPHIES belonging to the BSPS, the BSPS Championships Show or a BSPS Area are not returned by the requested date. A surcharge of £10 will be charged if cheques have to be represented,</u>

6. The judges listed in the schedule have accepted our invitation to judge but the committee reserve the right to appoint substitutes should any of the appointed judges withdraw or classes over run.

7. THE TIMETABLE IS PROVISIONAL AND THE COMMITTEE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO AMEND AT THEIR DISCRETION. Every effort is made to avoid clashing of classes, but IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE COMPETITOR TO ENSURE THEY CAN COMPETE IN THE CLASSES ENTERED. THE COMMITTEE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO CANCEL THE SHOW

BSPS RULES

This show is affiliated to the BSPS, and all classes are held in accordance with the 2025 Rule & Show Handbook and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the BSPS including the disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS. Please take note of Rule 63 (1) a regarding DOPE Testing in the 2025 BSPS Rule book. Pony, Owners and riders must be BSPS members to compete in classes with qualification for BLUE RIBAND, RIHS (including Pretty Polly & Heritage classes) and animals must be registered with the BSPS, except for Anglo & PB Arabs who must be reg. with AHS.

HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW BRITISH SHOW PONY SOCIETY CHILDRENS RIDING PONY OF THE YEAR QUALIFIER

These classes will be run in accordance with the general rules as set out in the Horse of the Year Show rulebook, a copy of which can be downloaded from www.hoys.co.uk. Qualification will be confirmed by the Horse of the Year Show. See also additional notes in class 22 and ensure that these are complied with.

THE BSPS THOR ATKINSONS STEEL FABRICATIONS LTD CHALLENGE 2026

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Challenge. Animals must have qualified for the Challenge by attending any BSPS affiliated show and competed in the appropriate class. Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein Of Hunter Type, Open Show Pony, SHP, Open Cradle & Nursery Stakes, WHP, Int. SRT, SH & WH & Heritage Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden & WHP classes. Ponies must not have qualified for the HOYS 2026. If a pony qualifies for the HOYS 2026 it will forfeit its qualification for the BSPS Challenge.

THE BSPS BINKS FAMILY CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

At all BSPS affiliated shows the 1st prize-winners in the following classes will qualify for the Binks Family Champion of Champions; - Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Show Pony, Open WHP, Open SHP, Open LRHT, Open Intermediate SH, SRT & WH and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden & WHP classes.

At all BSPS affiliated shows the 1st Prize Winners in the Open Cradle & Nursery Stakes will qualify for the Binks Family Mini WHP Champion of Champions.

THE SHOWING REGISTER AMATEUR OF THE YEAR FINAL

This Show is a qualifier for the TSR Amateur of the Year Final to be held at Stoneleigh Park on the 6th & 7th December. EXHIBITS DO NOT NEED TO BE MEMBERS TO QUALIFY HOWEVER TSR MEMBERSHIP WILL BE REQUIRED FOR THEM TO COMPETE IN THE FINAL. BODY PROTECTORS

Body Protectors <u>MUST</u> be worn when jumping in any WHP and WH classes Including practice ring at B.S.P.S. Affiliated Shows. (Including Tiny Tots, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WSP, LRWSP and Training Stakes). Riders must wear a body protector when working in (practice jumps) and the jumping phase in all B.S.P.S. organised and affiliated events. A British Equestrian Trade Association (BETA) approved and appropriately labelled "Level 3 body protector" 2018 (Blue) shown on the label. BETA recommends body protectors are replaced at least every three to five years, after which the impact absorption properties of the foam may have started to decline. Air jackets may be worn. If a member chooses to wear an air jacket, they are allowed in addition to a normal body protector which meets BETA 2018 level 3 standard. Air jackets must not be worn under any jacket or body protector and numbers must be fitted with elasticated fastenings. When an air jacket inflates the sudden noise can startle horses, thereby causing difficulties for other members in confined areas e.g. Indoor schools and menages. Therefore, air jackets are not encouraged to be used in those areas except for medical reasons.

<u>HATS</u>

Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats no: PAS 015 2011, VG1(BS) EN1384 2023, ASTM F1163 2015 & 2023, SNELL E2016 & E2021 onwards, AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards, MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet Covers are encouraged. Hat TAGGING in BSPS classes is encouraged – we will tag hats at this show if needed (British Eventing, British Riding Club and Pony Club tags are accepted). Please note no beaglers allowed in CHAPS or BSPA classes at this show. Further information P12 BSPS Rule Book 2025.

Getting to Warren Farm using the new link road (A5758)

PLEASE DO NOT USE SAT NAV FROM THE END OF THE MOTORWAYS - FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS BELOW.

From the M58

Follow the M58 to the end then take directions to the A59, be prepared to turn right on the A5758 when directed and continue to the A565. Follow the A565 for approx. 4 miles at second large roundabout turn right (BP garage on left) the entrance to Warren Farm is clearly signed a few yards up on the right.

From the M57

When approaching the end of the M57 keep looking for signs A5758. At traffic lights there are 5 lanes, the two left hand lanes will take you towards Aintree. To access the A5758 you need to be in the third lane to continue straight on to the new link road which will take you to the A565.

Follow the A565 for approx. 4 miles at second large roundabout turn right (BP garage on left) The Entrance to Warren Farm is clearly signed a few yard up on the right.

FROM THE MERSEY TUNNEL

Follow A565 (Southport) to Formby (12 miles). At second large roundabout turn right (BP garage on left) The Entrance to Warren Farm is clearly signed a few yards up on the right.

Exhibitors are required by DEFRA to carry with them Official Identity Documents for all horses/ponies when competing or travelling. Competitors are reminded that it is a DEFRA requirement that the Official Identity Documents must be in the name of the legal owner within 30 days of ownership. This must be registered with the breed society, relevant studbook or ID issuing agency, dependant on breed/type of animal. Spot checks may be carried out at qualifying shows and by breed societies. These classes will be run in accordance with the general rules as set out in the Horse of the Year Show rulebook, a copy of which can be downloaded from www.hoys.co.uk. This is a Horse of the Year Show Qualifier, all data given upon entry of this class is provided to Grandstand Media Limited and stored on the Grandstand Entries System.
